SAMMY'S STORY

Sammy was locked in a dark, filthy shed on a farm in Garvagh, with 6 other dogs for a very long time. The other dogs were small and could move about inside the shed but Sammy was chained to the wall by a two foot rusty chain. He couldn't reach the dirty water bucket and he would have got the least food that was thrown into them every few days. He was filthy, emaciated and terrified of people and his eyes were sensitive to light. A member of the public made a call to the centre and all the animals were rescued from their horrific conditions.

We saw Sammy on the Rainbow website about 2 weeks before we brought him home, when we went to see him, he was very withdrawn and spent all his time in his own company. He was unsure of our other dog and our 3 cats also, but they happily left him alone until he settled in. He slept in the living room in his new bed for a few weeks, but now he sleeps on my bed. He loves his 3 walks a day and now has enough confidence to walk about 10 steps ahead then he waits on us to catch up. He loves to bounce on the sofa when we come home from work, and wags his tail so hard he almost falls over.

Sammy is a true part of our family now, and instead of laying there with no heart he's recovering well and seems to have a smile on his face, we definitely chose the correct dog to complete our already big family, he fits right in.
